Summary: To serve and strengthen the church by mobilizing the FBC community into increased and more effective missions engagement, both locally and globally. This is a high-level role that will oversee and work with the Missions Team and part-time missions staff to accomplish the following duties.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities Include the Following:

- General
 - Build upon current missions program, while helping to develop new strategies for the future.
 - Oversee policies, budget, missions ministry goals and objectives.
 - Continually challenge our church family to think and live missionally, both locally and globally.
 - Help organize and plan missions Sundays and annual Missions Fair.
 - Develop a strategy for championing each local and international partner.
 - Function as an integral member of the Pastoral Team, attend weekly Pastor meetings, and collaborate with other ministries.
 - Meet consistently with the Pastor of Ministries.
 - Meet consistently with the Missions Administrator.
 - Lead the Missions Team and meet consistently for input.
- Specific responsibilities for Global Missions
 - Mobilize, equip and send short-term and long-term missionaries internationally.
 - Help plan and organize ongoing short-term mission trips to international partners.
 - Build and maintain relationships with international partners through regular church engagement and a healthy schedule of field visitation.
 - Develop strategic plans for potential future international partnerships.
 - Develop a strategic missionary care plan for international missionaries.
- Specific Responsibilities for Local Missions
 - Mobilize and equip church members for local outreach.
 - Help plan and organize local outreach events in and for the community.
 - Build and maintain relationships with local partners through regular church engagement and consistent communication with partner leadership.
 - Assess the strengths of our current local partners and develop a comprehensive strategic plan for local engagement moving forward.

- Help cast vision, connect and mobilize other ministries in the church to strategically engage the surrounding community.
